Market Space Pass

Vendor Contract

The Fairview Farmers Market (FFM) will be held each Saturday morning from 9 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. from the sXXXXd Saturday in June until the third Saturday in October with the exception of Tuesday the 24th of July when a special market will be held and the following Saturday omitted.

Food Vendors (This paragraph does not apply to vendors of unprocessed fruit and garden produce.)

The Utah Department of Agriculture and Food will make inspections and ask questions of food vendors. Food vendors agree to read and abide by that Department's Outdoor Market Requirements. See information in the Guide for New Vendors: <http://fairviewfarmersmarket.com/vendors-guide/> for details. There are special requirements for cottage kitchens, food labelling, ready-to-eat foods, and for raw foods like meat and eggs. Food vendors must attach copies of any required permits to this Application & Contract. **Your Application & Contract cannot be fully processed without copies of your permits.**

Craft Vendors

Only hand-crafted, original items are acceptable. Examples are quilts, home sewn items, knit or crocheted items, lace work, tooled leather, hand-knapped arrow heads, photography, paintings, homemade lotions and soaps, herbal products, metal work, wreaths, ceramics, etc.

All Vendors

A vendor must sell only those items listed on his original or amended application form. The vendor shall operate his space at his own risk. Fairview Farmers Market shall not in any way be responsible for any injuries, damages or other losses. Breach of these covenants or conduct deemed unsatisfactory solely by Fairview Farmers Market will result in immediate removal of the vendor. The undersigned vendor agrees to hold Charlet Pemberton and her associates harmless in the event of injury or loss of any type whatsoever.

Parking/ Set Up/Take down

Temporary parking while you are setting up is available in the CentraCom parking lot on Saturdays only. Be set up and have vehicles out of the way by 8:50 a.m. Take down is at 1:00 pm. You will maintain your space until that time and then clean up in and around your space before 2:00 pm. You have permission to use the Fairview City dumpster in its parking lot west of City Hall. Trash cans in the park are for customer use.

Agreement

The undersigned states that he is the authorized agent of this vendor, that he has researched and understood the requirements for the legal sale of his wares in this market, that Fairview Farmers Market has sole right without recourse to prohibit any event or the sale of any item which it deems a violation of its standards including but not limited to directing the vendor to vacate his space and leave the area, and that the undersigned agrees to all the terms and conditions of this Application & Contract.
